



### **Stephen R. Wicks, PhD, FRPharmS**

Steve is Professor of Pharmaceutical Sciences at the University of Greenwich, Visiting Professor of Pharmaceutics at the University of Bath and an Honorary Fellow of the School of Pharmacy, University College, London. He is a board member of AlgiPharma AS, Norway.

Prior to this he spent 25 years with Pfizer Inc. rising to become a Vice-President of Worldwide Pharmaceutical Sciences in the Pfizer Global Research and Development division and a member of the Pfizer UK Group Ltd board of directors.

Steve was responsible for the pharmaceutical development of 27 marketed Pfizer products, based on 19 active pharmaceutical ingredients, across both human and veterinary therapeutic areas. He is a Fellow and member of the Expert Scientific Advisory Panel of the Royal Pharmaceutical Society and a Fellow and board member of the Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences in Great Britain. He is on the indicative register of EU Qualified Persons.



### **Jeff Duke, C.Chem. C.Sci, FRSC**

Jeff Duke spent 22 years with Pfizer Inc. rising to become the Executive Director of Materials Science and Oral Product R&D. He enjoyed a diverse and varied career with Pfizer including assignments in the Asia Business Development Group and leading the multi-site European Analytical R&D Group in the UK and Germany.

He has extensive knowledge of regulatory chemistry, manufacturing and control strategies and was responsible for analytical method development, validation and release strategies for several Pfizer blockbuster medicinal products. He has developed extensive links with the academic community and was instrumental in creating major industrial analytical research centers at the Universities of Ghent and Tasmania. Earlier in his career he held research positions with Givaudin and the Forensic Science Service. He was educated at Sheffield Hallam University and is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Chemistry.
